NEW!!! 2019 Solar Rebate Program



Program Details

The new Marblehead Municipal Light Dept. (MMLD) Solar Rebate Program provides residential customers with a rebate of up to \$6,000 on the purchase and installation of PV solar panels on their homes.

The Program provides a solar rebate of up to \$1.20 per watt for the first 5 kilowatts of any residential project. Eligible solar installations must be 25 kilowatts or less. The solar arrays must have less than 20% shading, and facing between 150 and 270 degrees.

The Program runs through July 31, 2020 or until funds are exhausted



How to Apply for the Rebate

Please first contact MMLD at 781-631-5600 for solar installation permit information

Then submit the rebate application online with the Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company (MMWEC), our power supply partner. The application is online at www.mmwec.org. Customers can also call 413-308-1400 to check your application status



Step One

The homeowner submits their online rebate application to MMWEC for review. MMWEC forwards it to the Mass Dept of Energy Resources (DOER) for final approval



Step Two

After the DOER evaluates the application, customers will be notified of their rebate status.

Upon approval, customers have one year to schedule and complete installation of their solar panels. The rebate will be paid to the customer by MMWEC.
