General Manager's Report:

House Bill 2863:

It was moved by Commissioner Tumulty and seconded by Commissioner Maccario to support HB 2863, an act relative to greenhouse gas emissions standards for municipal lighting plants, for the purpose of promoting the Commonwealth's goals of reducing greenhouse gas emissions while acknowledging the statutory scheme of chapter 164 which places plant operations, finances and rates under local control. <u>Unanimous</u>

NREL

Doug Gagne and Andy Walker of NREL released their preliminary results for photovoltaic on school buildings which showed the potential for approximately 1,175 MWh/year. The schools include Village Elementary School (370 MWh/year), Veteran Middle school (342 MWh/year) and the Marblehead High School (463 MWh/year).
