General Manager Kowalik has been holding weekly meetings with PLM Engineer, Mike Barrett, MMLD Engineer, Colin Coleman, MMLD Distribution Manager William Jackson and former MMLD General Manager, Bob Jolly to discuss replacing Village 13 transformers and switchgear. Request for bids in the next two weeks. A delivery time frame of about 50 – 60 weeks with the intent to be operational by end of 2023.

2050 Roadmap to Net Zero:

The Commissioners had a lengthy discussion on their roadmap to 2050. Commissioner Frechette suggested that the Commission lead by example by establishing specific ambitious goals to decarbonize by 2040. General Manager, Joe Kowalik, requested of Matt Ide (MMWEC), who was attending the meeting remotely, to create a roadmap for both 2040 and 2050 for the Board's consideration. Commissioner Wolf requested that the Roadmap take into account an increase in demand of at least doubling over that time period. The Commission will continue the decarbonization dialog at their next meeting.
